English artist David Millidge will be showing many abstract ceramic works which explore how the repetition of simple building blocks grow into complex organic forms. This will be his first solo show at D Contemporary.

The highlight of the exhibition will be David's emotive semi-abstract busts. Using industrial design, fashion and sci-fi movies as inspiration, these fantasy idols evoke feelings of power and worship.

About David

After studying sculpture at St Martin's School of Art, London, from 1969 (the year of 'The Locked Room') to 1972, David concentrated on raising a family and building a footwear import business. Although marketing gave him the opportunity to use his creativity, he had to wait until retirement, before devoting himself to fine art. His current work explores how simple forms can be used as building blocks to create complex structures. Multiple architectural shapes, combined with organic elements, evolve into flowing sculptures.

David likes to use the unpredictability of ceramic glazes to produce unique surfaces which add texture to his semi-abstract creations.
